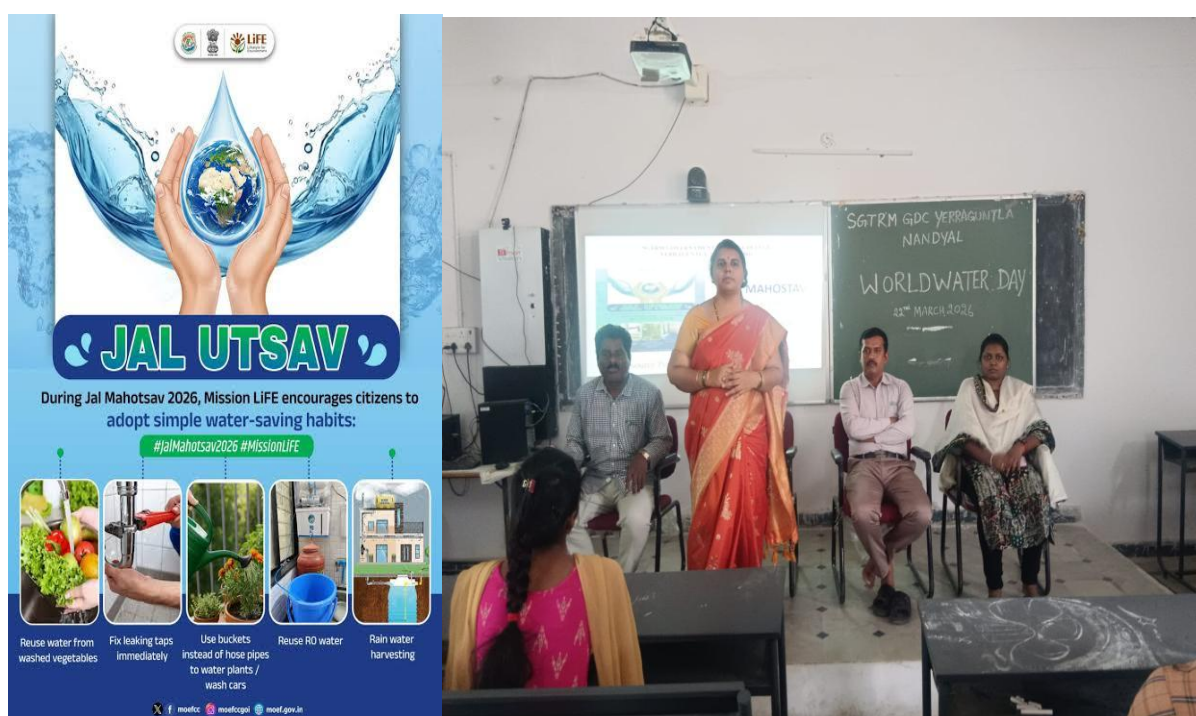
WORLD WATER DAY

Brief Report: On 4th Saturday 28th March-2026 the SGTRM GDC, Yerraguntla, Nandyal Dist. AP conducted awareness Programme to students on “**Source Segregation & Zero Waste Lifestyles**” conducted under Swachha Andhra Programme. The Chairperson, Dr. G. Indravathi and , SASA Convener Sri E. Sanjay Kumar , The Teaching, Non – Teaching Staff & 41 Students were participated in this programme. The Principal stated that on source segregation and zero waste lifestyles is that **waste is not "garbage" but a resource** that must be managed through a circular, "cradle-to-cradle" approach rather than a linear "take-make-dispose" model.

Source Segregation and a **Zero Waste Lifestyle** directly impacts environmental sustainability by reducing landfill dependency and conserving natural resources. These practices transform the traditional "take-make-dispose" model into a circular economy where materials are treated as valuable resources rather than trash.
